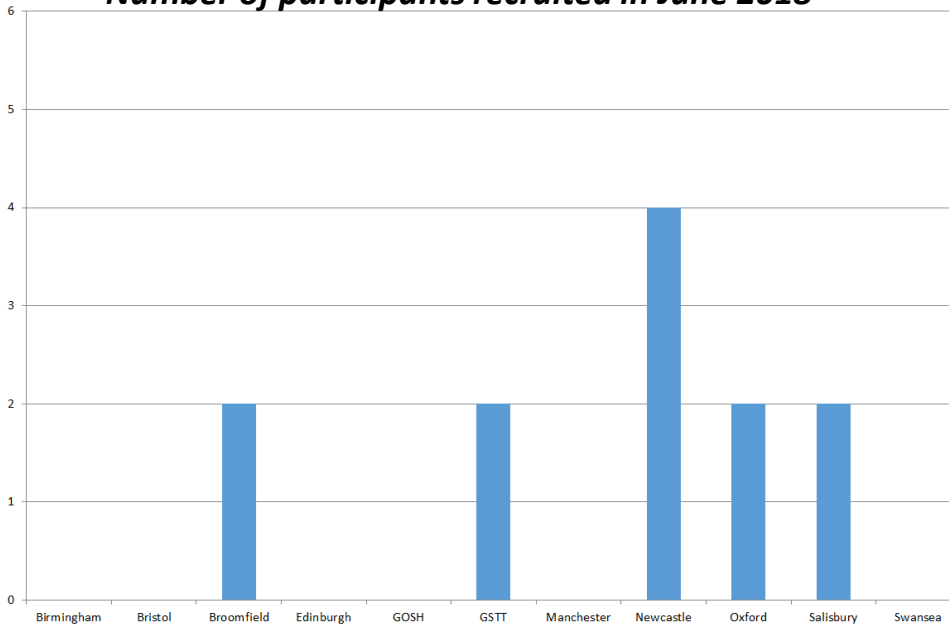

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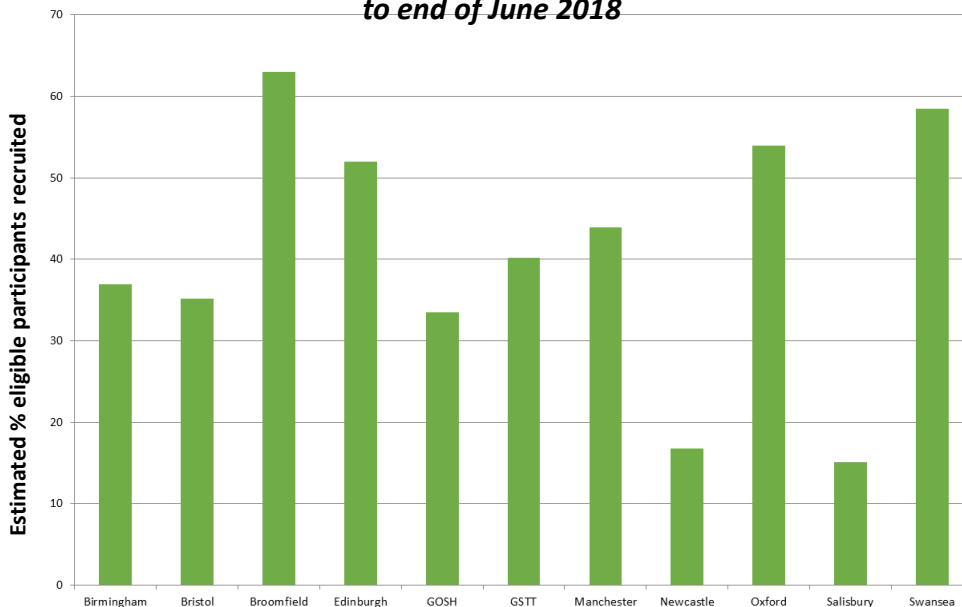
Number of participants recruited in June 2018
