

How to make a “Jump” Cell - Grid 3

In this video we will show you how to create a jump cell by jumping to a new page. We will also show you how to copy a template page which will include all action cells. For the purpose of this video, we are using Supercore 50.

We are going to add a new topic. To do this we are going to go on to our topics page, so click on “Topics”. To edit the grid, you must be in “editing mode”. To do this, press on the menu bar, and then select “edit grid”. You will notice now that we are in editing mode, there is a label at the top telling you which page you are on. We are going to add a jump cell in a new row. To do this we select the cell, and then double click on “create cell” – from there, click on “jump to”.

As mentioned earlier, we are going to copy a template to ensure we have all the action cells and sentence bar at the top of the screen. To do this first we have to search for the template page, so just start typing “template page”. We are in the topics, so we are going to click on “topics template” once, and then click on “copy grid”. Here you will be asked to name your topic. So, I’m just going to name it, TV. Make sure you leave the first part as it is, “15 topics dash”, and just change the name. Click on “OK”. You can see my jump has now been created.

But I don’t want it to say, “15 topics TV”, I just want it to say “TV”. So, I’m going to click on the cell and then “change label”, and I’m just going to type “TV”. Now you can choose a picture from the one that the grid has suggested automatically, or you can always click on find picture in order to find a different one. I’m just going to click on that one.

So, to see if my jump works, I can click on my cell, and then click on “follow jump”. I see that my jump takes me to a new empty page, and if we read the label on the top of the screen, it says “15 topics TV” which is the name I gave it just before. That shows me that it’s actually my page and that I’m not going to edit the old existing template.
