## Withdrawal of Faecal Reducing Substances / Sugar Chromatography analysis

With support from the Paediatric Gastroenterology team at the Bristol Children's Hospital and in line with University Hospitals Bristol Metabolic Laboratory we have taken the decision to withdraw Faecal reducing substances (sugar chromatography) from our test repertoire here at Southmead Hospital in Bristol.

This test has historically been requested to screen faeces for the presence of lactose to support a diagnosis of lactose intolerance as a cause of osmotic diarrhoea. However, there is a lack of published evidence to support its use in this context. Trialling a lactose free diet and monitoring symptoms, is likely to be more informative.
