We work in Southmead Hospital

Who do we support?

We support anyone over the age of 16 who are using services in Southmead Hospital.

The people we see must be known to their local Community Learning Disabilities Team (CLDT).



Our Aim

is to ensure people with learning disabilities have equal access to health care, to make you feel safe and supported when visiting Southmead hospital.



We can support you with:

- Inpatient and emergency admissions
- Day surgery
- Outpatient appointments
- Planned admissions











What support can we offer you?

We can consider what support you need whilst you are in hospital to make you feel safe.

We can help to change things in the hospital to make them easier for you (**reasonable** adjustments)

We can support you to understand what is being said and what needs to happen.

We can make sure that you are listened to.

We can talk to:

- your family and carers
- your local Community Learning Disability Teams (CLDT)
- your care provider
- other relevant professionals (e.g. your GP or your social worker)

We provide hospital passports so that staff know how to support you.

We support hospital staff to help them understand the needs of people with learning disabilities.

We can meet you for a tour of the hospital.

We can support you if you are scared of hospitals or treatment.
