2039 End date: 31/08/2019	UK CHIC	The UK CHIC Study is a collaboration of 20 large HIV clinics in the UK. The study was initiated in 2001 with the aim of establishing a large database of HIV positive individuals in order to provide detailed clinical data on large numbers of patients in the UK. The purpose of the study is to analyse the data to monitor the uptake of therapy; to identify the factors associated with the virological and immunological response to treatment; and to monitor clinical events and survival among individuals with HIV in the UK. Other research themes include: HIV and pregnancy; HIV and hepatitis co-infiection; and HV and ageing.  Routinely collected data from clinical databases at each of the collaborating centres are merged into a single database, and the dataset is updated on an annual basis. Information is provided on patient demographics, clinical events, deaths, antiretroviral treatment, attendance, and CD4, viral load, hepatitis, toxicity and HLA-B57 tests.
2769 End date: 31/10/2020	UKPID Registry	UK version of the ESID Online Database  The primary goal of the HLH Registry is to collect data relevant for assessment of feasibility and design of future interventional studies on the treatment of HLH. This requires a detailed analysis of the target patient population treated by centres potentially participating in such studies. As such this is a pilot or enabling study.
