### Extension to Scope of Accreditation

Severn Pathology will comply with the requirements of all relevant regulatory bodies and is committed to the use of examination procedures that will ensure the acceptable quality of all tests performed and are fit for their intended use.

The accredited scope of activity for the department is given in the UKAS schedule. From time to time, amendments to this scope may be required, examples include addition of new tests or changes to test methodology. In such cases, the department will apply for Extension to Scope from UKAS. The following tests are currently in this process.

<b>Neutrophil Function: Oxidative Burst</b>	Heparinised plasma	ETS reagent change from Phagoburst kit to DHR123 kit, both on FACSLytic Flow Cytometer.
<b>Avian Precipitins</b>	Serum	New assay by ImmunoCAP 250 Allergy
<b>Quantiferon</b>	Specialised Tubes	ETS platform change from Dynex DS2 QUANTA Lite ELISA to Liason chemiluminescent immunoassay
<b>Faecal Elastase</b>	Faecal Sample	ETS platform change from Dynex DS2 ELISA to Alpha Labs BA200 Immunoturbidimetric
