The Neonatal Intensive Care unit at Southmead Hospital is a well-established Level 3 unit providing a centre of excellence for babies requiring medical and neurological assessment and treatment. We have 34 cots, compromising of 8 ITU, 8 HDU and 18 SC, with an additional 10 cots on our Transitional Care Ward. As a Regional referral centre, we take patients from 23 week gestation and sick babies from our network and further afield. Family integrated care is at the forefront of our ethos and we are working towards the BLISS charter and we have just submitted the stage 1 application for UNICEF Baby Friendly Initiative for neonatal units.

We value nurse education at the unit and have an established practice development team to support and guide our nursing staff.
