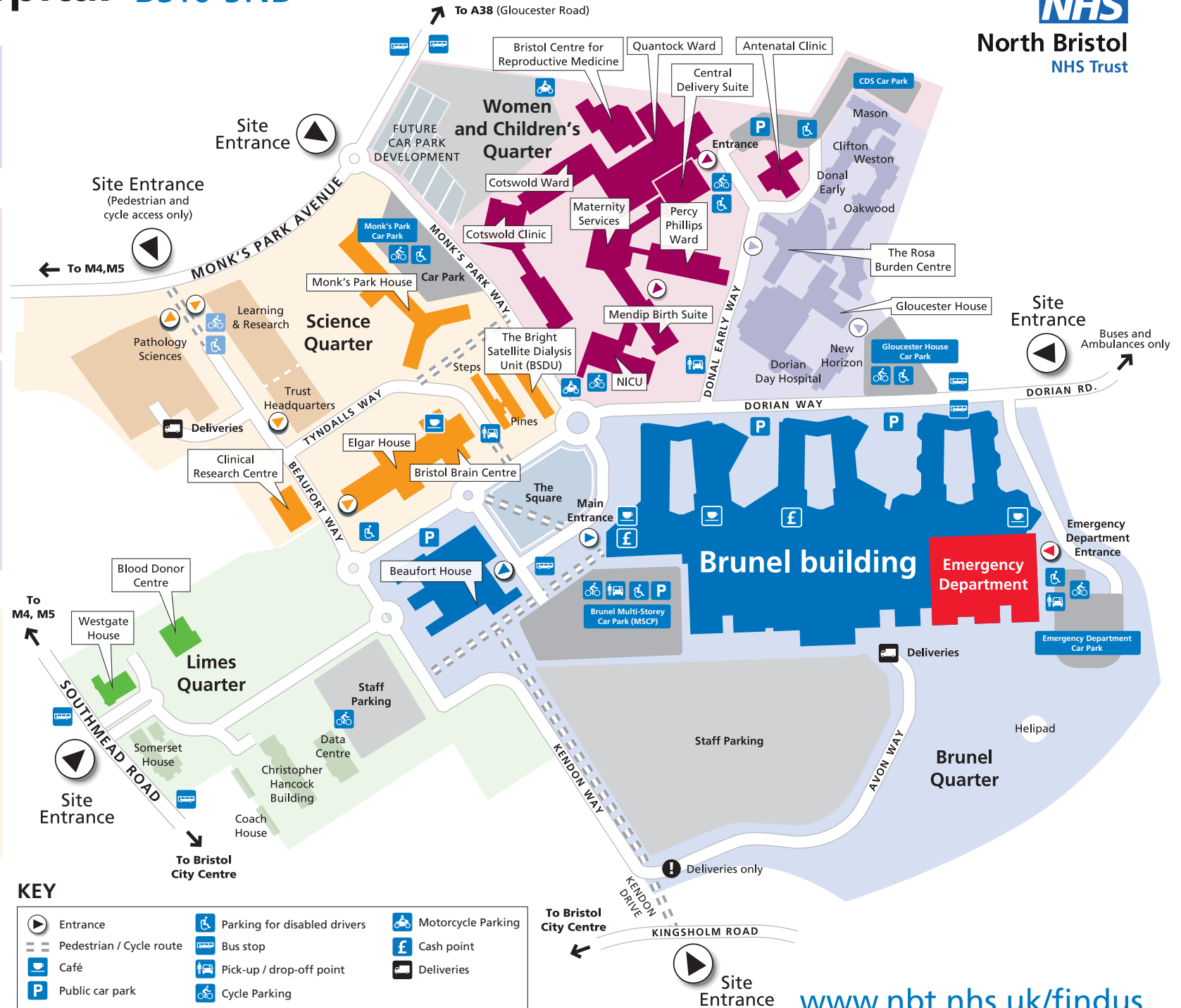

By Bus

There are over 15 bus services that call at or near Southmead Hospital, many of which will bring you straight to the main entrance of the Brunel building. Real time information regarding bus times is available within the Atrium of the building and at the bus stops.

By Bicycle

By Train

By Motorcycle

Motorcycle parking is free on site and there are a number of designated motorcycle parking areas. Please see the attached map for details.

Car Parking

Some of our car parks work via automatic number plate recognition (ANPR). Pay by credit/debit card, notes or coins when you return to the car park.

All other visitor parking is pay and display. Please make sure you bring sufficient change for parking.

For long term parking options, visit the Security Travel and Parking office in the atrium of the Brunel building open from 6am-8:30pm, or call 0117 414 3334.

Charges apply 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. Tariffs are clearly displayed in all public car parks and can be obtained by calling the OCS office. For long term parking at a reduced rate contact the OCS office for more information.

Disabled drivers, displaying a blue badge, park free of charge and disabled parking bays are provided in all public car parks. If there are no available disabled bays you may park in any space within a public car park free of charge provided that you display your blue badge. For disabled parking in our ANPR car parks, please see instructions on payment machines before you exit.

The map overleaf highlights public parking areas. Please ensure that you do not park in staff car parks as only permit holders may park in these areas, particularly as a barrier card is needed to exit them.

Terms and Conditions of parking. Please be advised that failure to comply with the Terms and Conditions of parking as displayed within the car parks may lead to enforcement.
